

# 2023: REGAINING MOMENTUM



Monthly overnight visitor arrivals gradually improved throughout the year. Despite a slowdown in the pace of recovery during the peak summer period, by the end of the year monthly arrivals reached 96% of 2019 levels.

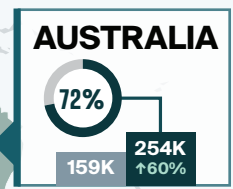
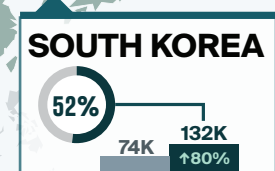
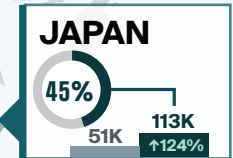
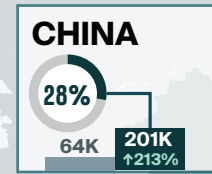
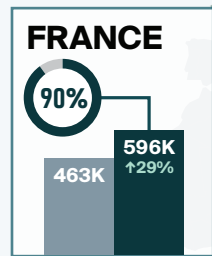
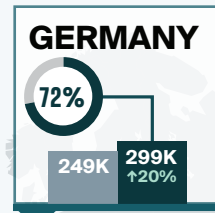
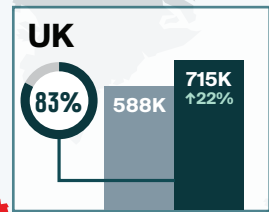
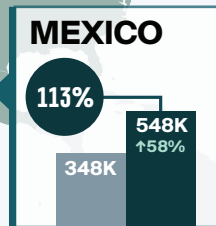
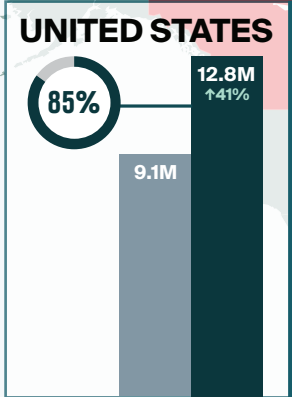
## Total overnight arrivals



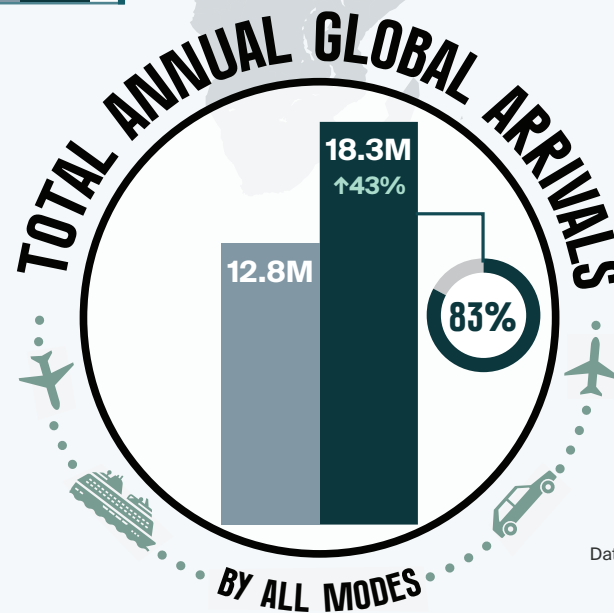
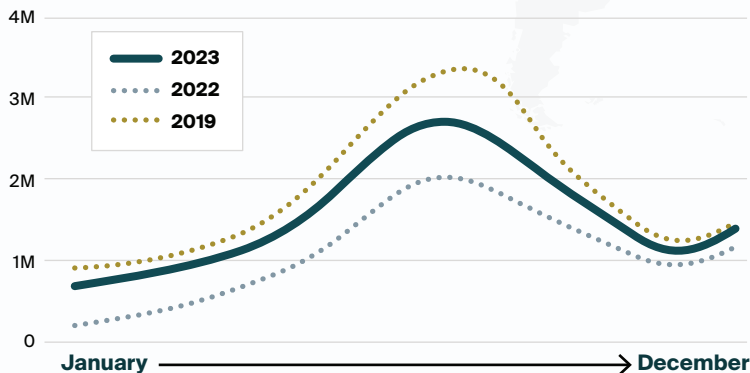

After reopening its borders to international travel in late summer 2021, Canada removed all COVID-19 border regulations on October 1, 2022.

The strong arrivals recovery recorded in 2023 was led by Mexico, France, the US, and the UK.



## Monthly overnight arrivals



Canada welcomed 18.3 million overnight visitors in 2023, an increase of 43% over 2022, to reach 83% of annual 2019 arrivals.



Overnight arrivals are preliminary estimates and are subject to change.
